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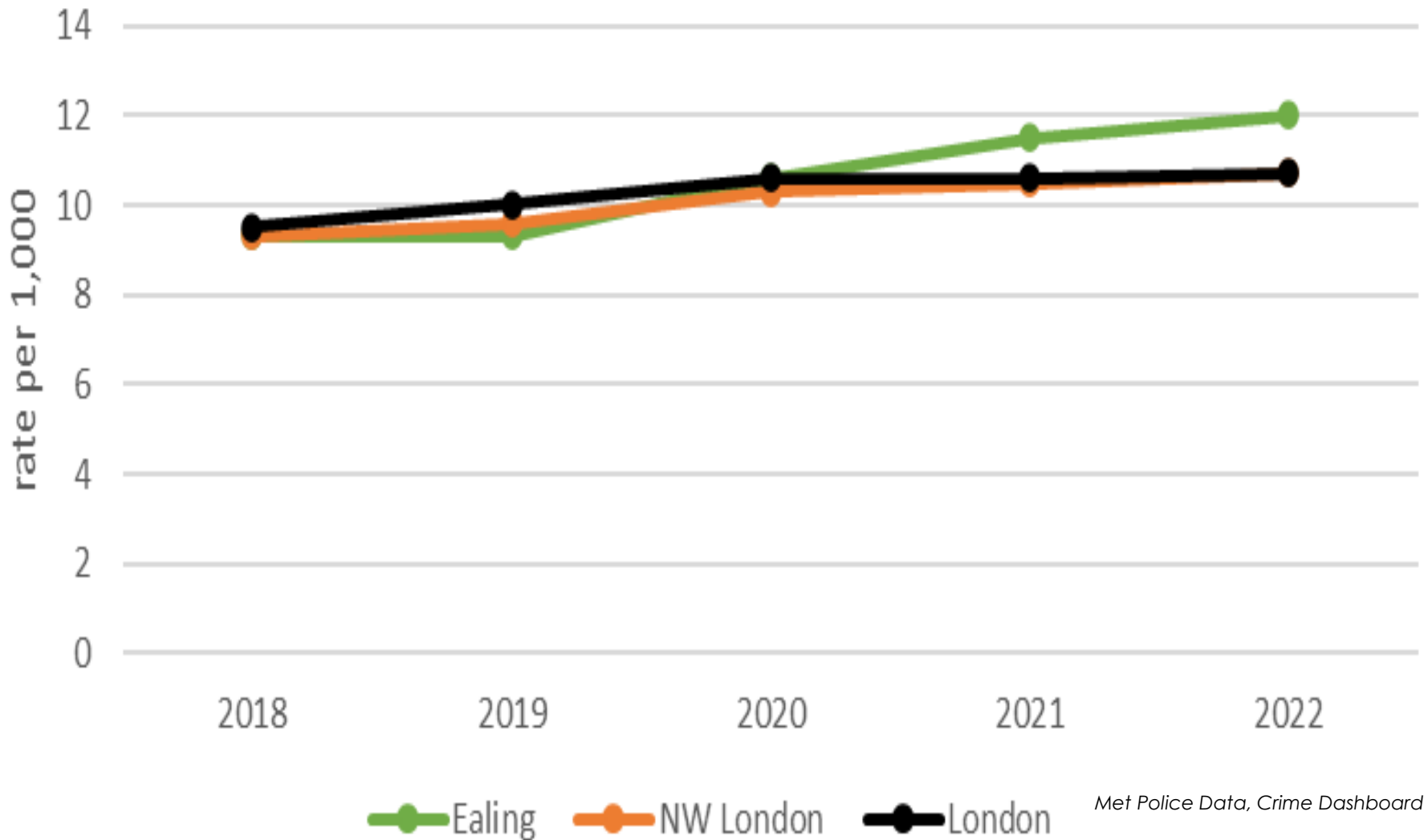

# Standard 9: Domestic Abuse

## Aims

- To improve identification of people experiencing Domestic Abuse within GP practices in Ealing.
- To ensure safety of the victims identified (including their dependents - children and elderly)
- To ensure victims identified are referred effectively for the provision of on-going advice, information and support.
- To increase public awareness and help break down any stigma.

# Standard 9: Domestic Abuse

The provider is required to meet the below Key Performance Indicators:

1. Assign 1 or 2 clinical 'Domestic Abuse Champion(s)'. Clinical team to complete training on Domestic Abuse and safeguarding (adults and children)
2. Practice to run baseline search audit of 'history of domestic abuse' register and provide data on:
  - The number of newly diagnosed people experiencing Domestic Abuse (adults and children)
  - The number of victims referred to local Domestic Abuse support services (or declined)
3. Promote your practice as a 'domestic abuse awareness practice'

# Domestic Abuse 2023/24: History



North West London

If the patient (and any children / vulnerable adults) are in immediate danger dial 999 and initiate child protection / adult safeguarding procedures.  
 Be extra vigilant during remote consultations as perpetrator may be around. Ensure confidentiality, unless safety is questioned.  
 ALL information in the EMR (Electronic Medical Record) about domestic abuse MUST be hidden from patient online access.

## History

Use "history of DA" code for both adults and children

Blue fields are Enhanced Services items for Ealing only

**History of domestic abuse**

Clinical enquiry about domestic abuse: current and past history

Dependants in household <18y and vulnerabl... (include age, gender and any disabilities)

Lacks capacity to give consent (Mental Capacity Act 2005)

Safeguarding concern

Risk assessment done

## Risk assessment

**Adult assessment: Use SPECSS+ SafeLives Dash risk checklist**

- Separation (<2yrs)
- Escalation
- Stalking & harassment
- Strangulation
- Pregnancy
- Cultural isolation
- Sexual abuse

**Child assessment: use Barnardos Risk Identification Matrix**

## Referrals

Referral to safeguarding children team

Referral to safeguarding adults team

Referral to multi-agency risk assessment conference (MARAC)

**Referral to domestic abuse support services**

Referral declined: reason

Referral to police

Consent given to share patient data with specified 3rd party

Consent withdrawn to share pt data with specified 3rd party (give reason)

*Clinicians to override non-consent and share information to keep an individual safe*
