Studies show that one in five consultations in General Practice are driven by a social need

Studies show there is a strong correlation (in both directions), between health conditions

Those that have health issues, long term health conditions and disabilities often require welfare advice and support accessing social care packages, (e.g. those with health

- issues that mean they have to stop work) Those with poor social determinants of health, such as living in poverty, including food and fuel poverty, in poor quality or overcrowded housing are more likely to develop long term health conditions and find it harder to manage them Those with unmanageable debt are more likely to develop mental health issues, while those with mental health issues are more likely to develop debt issues
