This preceptorship funding has been confirmed in the last 2 weeks. The eligibility criteria for preceptorship funding has been expanded to include: · All existing PAs in Primary Care who have not previously undertaken a preceptorship, including those in their first role.

- Employers seeking additional assurance for their PAs, even if they are not newly qualified, to help cover enhanced supervision costs.

If disposed of in domestic waste, they may end up in landfill, releasing any remaining greenhouse gases into the atmosphere. Additionally, the plastics from inhalers cannot be recycled through domestic recycling systems. Returning inhalers to community

The NHS North West London Medicines Optimisation Team has created resources to help healthcare professionals encourage patients to return their used and unwanted inhalers to community

pharmacies for safe disposal ensures they are incinerated with other medical waste, reducing their environmental impact compared to landfill disposal.
