Incels & Misogyny

This course is designed to raise awareness, identification and intervention with regard to incels and incel ideology and to understand the misogynist language used by incels. Despite having existed for decades, this fringe online ideology is becoming increasingly mainstream with far reaching implications for misogyny, radicalisation of young people, men's mental health and women's safety. Given the increasing instances of real-world violence, it is more important than ever that we gain a deep and accurate understanding of incel ideology, its context and how to effectively safeguard and referrals for those affected.

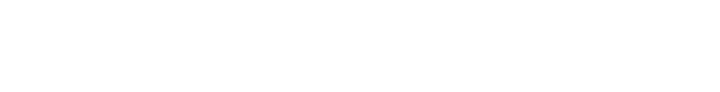
