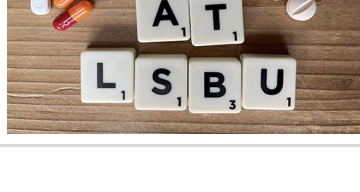
### Non-Medical Prescribing Study Day at LSBU
