- Observe how reflective listening can help when emotions are running high.
- Discover how questions, reflections, affirmations and summaries can be used to facilitate a more effective conversation about behaviour change.

### ARRS funded nurse roles

The recent release of the Primary Care Network Directed Enhanced Services (DES), confirmed the addition of other nurse roles now eligible for Additional Roles Reimbursement Scheme funding.

### Deprivation health: a master’s-level module for frontline impact

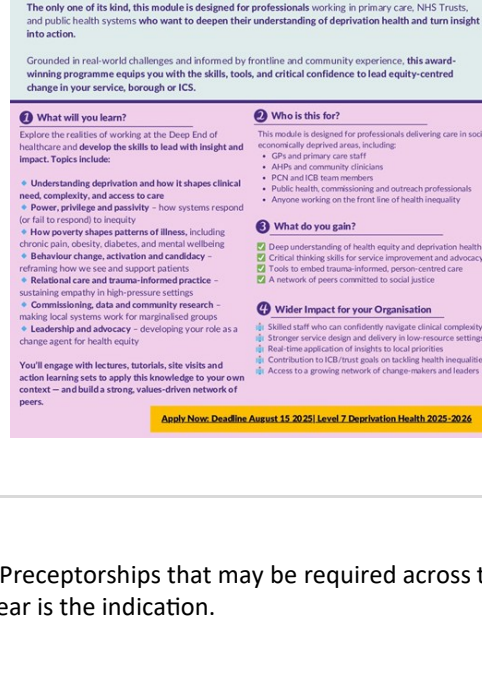

### Expressions of interest for PG Cert in Clinical Education

What is a PG Cert in Education?

The Post Graduate Certificate in Education is a year long course in a university and is all about learning how to teach, supervise, assess and evaluate within a Clinical setting. For example, you may want to become, or already are a Nurse Education Lead in your PCN. This course will give you an excellent foundation to develop your skills and knowledge and enable you to further your educational career.

Who is the Training for?

The funding is aimed at General Practice Nurses who want to become involved in the Education and Training of others in the clinical setting.

When does the course start and What is the time commitment?

The courses start in September and last a full academic year. You will probably need to take a day out of work a week to complete this course but this will not be the case for every week. You will also need to allow time at weekends etc to complete assignments.

What are the entry requirements?

You need to have studied to degree level in the past to study at a Post Graduate level.

How is it funded?

(Pending funding approval from WTE) There may be a limited budget to cover the cost of the course which is paid directly to the university. There may also be a limited bursary which will be provided to your employing practice for supervision and education support (and to possibly cover for when you are not working).

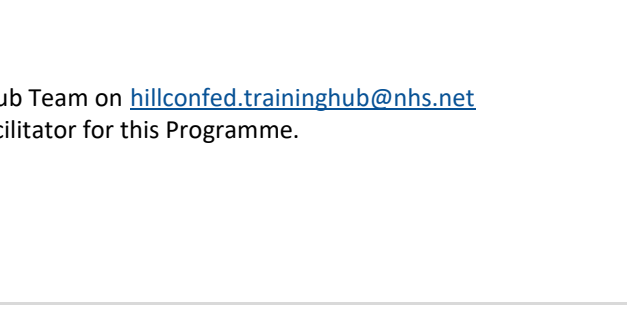

This programme to date has successfully demonstrated a 13% reduction in stress and anxiety across the 533 NWL workforce who have taken part (and this is only early findings, we anticipate this figure rising).
