

This two-day training will be run twice between May and June 2026. The development is the same for each date, but we are targeting one cohort at GP surgeries and one at PCNs.

This two-day learning blends theory and practical application. Join peers from across North West London as Moonraker guides you through the tool the British military uses to plan battles and strategise – the 7 questions.

It's a systematic tool for analysing a problem and the team's role in solving it, generating options of how to solve them and to evaluate them.

This is a fantastic tool for planning anything, in any industry. It is particularly effective. The 7 questions can be used as they are as a very rudimentary planning method but more effectively are used in association with a range of other tools and processes which Moonraker will teach you. The original military method has been adapted for non-military use by the team.

- You're a clinical or non-clinical leader who is trying to take a proactive approach to planning, or who feels stuck, and just need a clear, tried and tested approach to planning, as well as the confidence to bring your team along in that planning.


