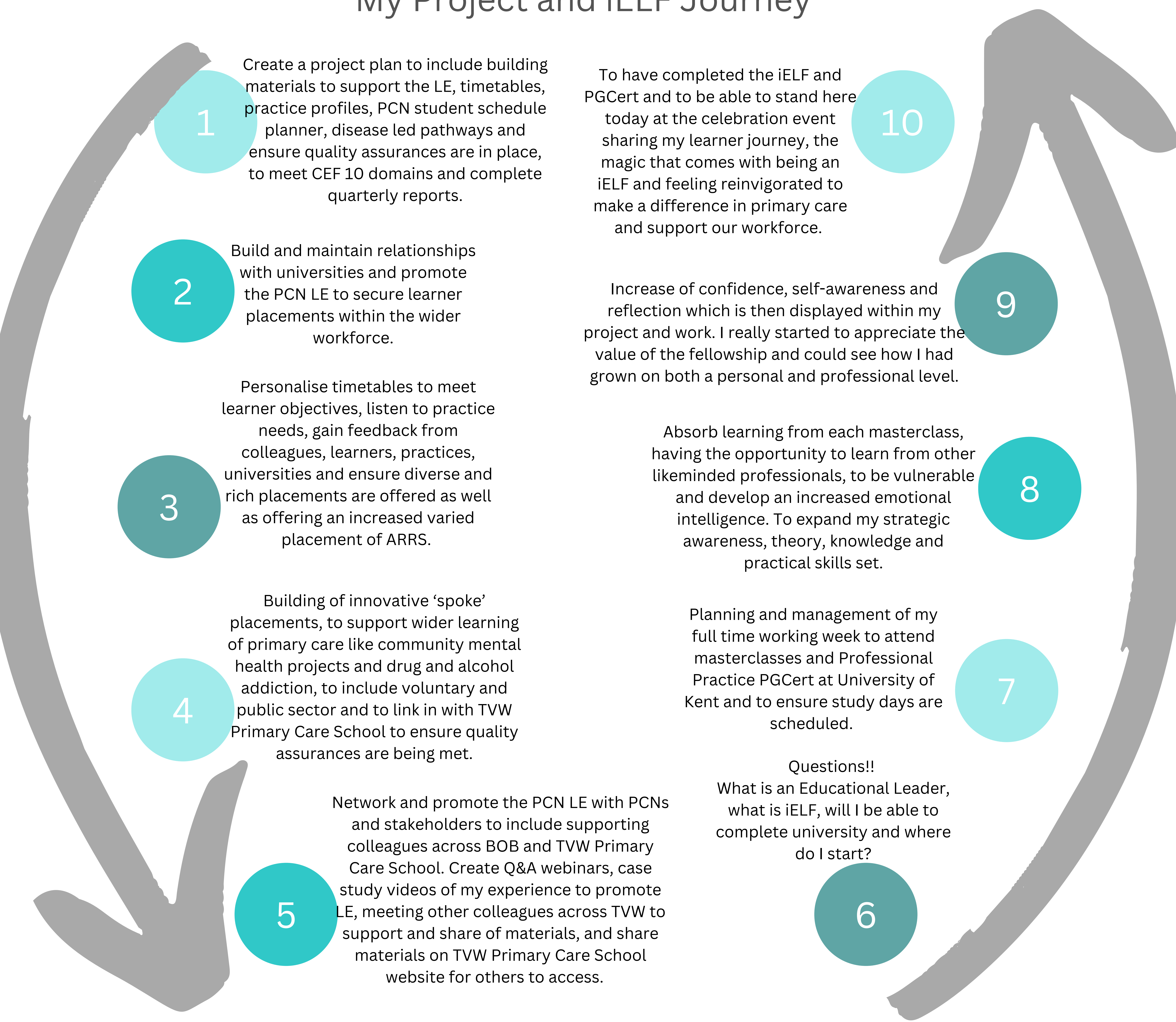


Interprofessional Educational Leadership Fellowship (iELF) 23-24
